

Detailed casualty-lists of the Prussian army, 16th June 1815.

1st army-corps.

1st brigade:

2nd Silesian Jäger-battalion nr.6:

Killed: 1 officer, 4 subalterns, 8 men. Wounded: 2 officers, 4 subalterns, 77 men. Missing: 6 men – total: 102 ¹

1st regiment of Silesian hussars:

Killed: 6 subalterns and 3 men. Wounded: 16 men. ²

24th regiment of infantry:

Total losses: 14 officers and 340 men (half of them in the 2nd battalion). ³

2nd brigade:

1st regiment of West-prussian infantry nr.6:

16 officers, 57 subalterns, 13 musicians, 868 men (15 and 16th of june). ⁴

3rd brigade:

2nd West-prussian regiment nr.7:

1st and 2nd battalion: Killed: 3 officers, 9 subalterns, 1 musician and 50 men. Wounded: 14 officers, 18 subalterns, 7 musicians and 257 men. Missing: 34 men. Total: 393. ⁵

29th regiment:

Killed: 3 officers, 5 subalterns, 50 men. Wounded: 10 officers, 17 subalterns, 6 musicians, 259 men. Missing: 6 subalterns, 2 musicians, 118 men. Sub-total: 13 officers, 28 subalterns, 8 musicians and 427 men. Total: 476 ⁶

Foot battery nr.8:

Killed: 1 gunner. Wounded: 1 subaltern, 2 gunners. Missing: 1 subaltern and 4 gunners – total: 9 men. ⁷

4th brigade:

4th regiment of Westphalian Landwehr:

665 men (10 officers). ⁸

Total brigade:

Killed 4 officers, 24 subalterns, 8 musicians, 606 men. Wounded: 15 officers, 24 subalterns, 4 musicians, 479 men. Missing / prisoners of war: 5 officers, 101 subalterns, 24 musicians, 1271 men. Totals:

24 officers, 149 subalterns, 36 musicians, 2356 men – total: 2565. A large part of those missing later appeared to be killed or wounded. ⁹

Von Röder

5th regiment of Brandenburg dragoons:

Killed 3 officers, 3 subalterns, 1 trumpeter, 30 men. Wounded: 2 officers, 4 subalterns, 1 trumpeter, 38 men. Missing: 12 men. Total: 200 ¹⁰

3rd regiment Brandenburg uhlands:

This regiment lost 7 officers, 4 subalterns, 2 trumpeters and 121 uhlans – total: 134 ¹¹

Horse battery nr.2:

Killed: 3 gunners. Wounded: 3 gunners. Missing: 3 gunners. Prisoners: 1 gunner – total: 10 gunners. ¹²

Reserve artillery.

12p. battery nr.2:

Killed 2 gunners. Wounded: 13 gunners – total: 15 gunners. ¹³

12p. battery nr.6:

Killed: 5 gunners. Wounded: 9 gunners – total: 14 gunners. ¹⁴

Foot battery nr.1:

Killed: 6 gunners. Wounded: 12 gunners. Missing: 8 gunners – total: 26 gunners. ¹⁵

Howitzer battery nr.1:

Killed 3 gunners. Wounded: 10 gunners. Missing: 5 gunners – total: 18 gunners. ¹⁶

11th brigade:

Total: 3 officers, 6 subalterns, 3 musicians and 86 men. ¹⁷
